### Topics for Research:

1. **Love** (Does real love exist in the play? If so, who demonstrates this real love? How? Why?)
2. **Fate versus free-will** (Are in the actions and ultimately the conclusion of the play due to fate or free-will? Fate: Discuss examples of foreshadowing and dramatic irony seen throughout the play that reinforce this theme. Prove it with evidence from the play. Free-will: Discuss the characterization and actions of characters that directly impacted the ending of the play.)
3. **Gender roles** (How are gender roles portrayed in the play? Are they equal? What does this suggest?)
4. **Justice versus revenge** (Are the actions portrayed in *Romeo & Juliet* based on justice or revenge? What does this suggest?)
