# A grrrrreeattt example:

Think about the statement or argument you're trying to make.

- *Use evidence (exact words) from the text.*
- Explain how the quoted material proves your topic sentence/thesis statement.

Example One:

At first, Juliet has doubts about her future. *She tells Romeo that the marriage is “too rash, too unadvised, too sudden”* (Shakespeare 645). Juliet's hesitation illustrates her impressive foresight; she is able to see the possible consequences to their hasty actions.
