- 2. The power and value of ideas.

- 5. The power of conflicting ideas in developing a concept of truth, and the risk to the uneducated or ignorant of falling prey to propaganda.
- 6. The deadening power of technology when it suppresses or replaces true human interaction or experience.
- 7. The value and meaning of a free society. (While there are some risks to a free society, the threat of a society that suppresses freedom is the very possibility of being truly
