## The Great Gatsby: Quotes Project

- 1. Collect a minimum of 5 MEANINGFUL passages/quotes (including "The Quote of the Novel")
- 2. DISCUSS/DEFEND your choices in writing

#### **PROCEDURE**

- Use post-its to note/mark passages as you read. Every time you encounter a particularly important, provocative, dramatic, surprising, even disturbing passage, mark it with a post-it note.
- When you have completed the novel, review your selections, and decide which 5 are the most meaningful to you.
- Copy the passages down (including page numbers)
- In a well-written paragraph (1 PER QUOTE/PASSAGE):
  - EXPLAIN how the passage "fits" into the novel.
    - a. Who is speaking? To whom? About what?
    - b. Does the passage add to the character development, the plot line, the details of setting, etc?
  - 2. DISCUSS the importance of the passage to the book's THEME/MESSAGE/MEANING.
  - 3. REVEAL **WHY** you have selected this passage. Consider the following as suggested prompts or questions:
    - O Why does the passage impress, intrigue, horrify, or puzzle you?
    - O Do you find the author's use of language appealing or powerful?
    - O Does it prompt a strong response from you as you read it?
    - o Is the language beautiful, descriptive, graphic?
    - o Is it particularly meaningful? Is it a high point in the book?
    - o Does the passage remind you of a situation you have experienced, as well?
    - Does the author or the character raise intriguing questions or issues?
    - O Does the passage challenge or expand your thinking?
- "THE QUOTE OF THE BOOK"= the passage/quote that captures the essence the true meaning of the novel for you.

In a well-written paragraph explain exactly **HOW** this passage is the one perfect quote from the book [Think of this as the one passage that you would absolutely want saved should your book ever be lost or destroyed.]

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- All aspects of this assignment must be typed.
- Passages/quotes must be representative of the entire novel.
- All passages must be properly integrated into a sentence and include parenthetical documentation.
- Each paragraph has a MINIMUM of 8 SENTENCES + a clear, concise TOPIC SENTENCE
